Castles

Would you like to discover the unexpected splendour of the South Tyrolean middle ages? Visit the ancient castles, which are beautifully kept and filled with history and art, such as Maresch/Mareccio, Runkelstein/Roncolo, Haselburg/Flavon and Sigmundskron/Firmiano.



The vibrant fruit market is a cultural crossroads, offering fresh local produce and seasonal delights, open Monday to Saturday. Bolzano's farmers' markets add to the experience, held every Tuesday at Mazzini Square and Saturday at Rathausplatz, featuring fresh goods, homemade honey, and jams.
